

PROPOSAL FOR A RESOLUTION [3.2.]: THE RELATIONS BETWEEN UEF AND WFM

1 The Congress of the Union of European Federalists

2 **recognizing**

3 that uniting Europe is not simply a regional problem, but the first step in a process which is destined to lead to
4 unification of the whole world through World Federation, intended as the institution that can ensure world
5 peace;

6 the globalisation process has raised problems which cannot be addressed by a world system of nation-states;

7 regional and global governance institutions should be strengthened and democratised in order to meet global
8 challenges such as:

- 9 1. nuclear proliferation and peace,
- 10 2. climate change and sustainable development,
- 11 3. the financial and economic global crisis and reform of Bretton Woods institutions,
- 12 4. the erosion of democratic institutions and democratising the UN system,
- 13 5. the spread of violence and crime and the extension of the rule of law at international level;

14 Considering that since 2004 the UEF is member of the WFM,

15 **underlines**

16 that cooperation between UEF and WFM in Italy, France, Spain and the UK has led UEF member organisations
17 to become WFM member or associated organisations;

18 **encourages**

19 the other UEF member organisations to consider the opportunity to become WFM member or associated
20 organisations and to promote the merger of federalist organisations in the countries where European and
21 world federalist organisation coexist;

22 **invites**

23 to use The Federalist Debate – which is a joint publication of European and world federalists – to promote a
24 common theoretical and strategic vision;

25 **resolves**

26 that a WFM officer receive hospitality at the UEF headquarters in Brussels, in order to strengthen UEF-WFM
27 cooperation.
